## N.C. Association of School Administrators to move headquarters to Glenwood South

The North Carolina Association of School Administrators has acquired a law office building at 107 Glenwood Ave. in downtown Raleigh with plans to move its executive management and administrative office in the summer.

The School Administrators group is currently leasing space at 333 Fayetteville St. in Raleigh, and the new building acquisition will allow the group to expand. The building was purchased for \$1.8 million, according to county records.

The previous owners of the 6,100-square-foot building were law partners John and Paul Michaels of the Michaels & Michaels law firm. NCASA plans to take occupancy later this summer after a short-term leaseback with the law firm.

Cheshire Webb and Gary Lyons the **Avison Young** brokerage firm in Raleigh represented the seller in the transaction. Jake Jones, also of Avison Young, represented the school administrators group.
